# ADDENDUM 01: Directions for operating the TV & DVD player or the projector

## TV/DVD Set-up

- 1. Place the TV in front of the whiteboard.
- 2. Turn on the TV and DVD player.
- 3. Place the DVD in the DVD player.
- 4. The TV and DVD player already synced to video to play the video.
- 5. The TV remote controls the power and volume of the TV
- 6. The DVD remote controls a pause/play and rewind/fast forward features.

#### Projector Set-up

- 1. Press the power button on the top of the projector. It will turn from amber to green.
- 2. Place the DVD in the DVD slot located below the projector lens.
- 3. Use the two black switches on top of the lens to adjust the size and focus of the projection.
- 4. The volume and pause/play and rewind/fast forward features can be accessed using the remote or the control panel on the top of the projector.
- 5. Be sure to remove the DVD after showing the video and returning it to its case
