Materials/Time	Lesson Plan
Before Class Begins	 Arrive at Vita at least 15 minutes <u>before</u> class is scheduled to begin. Retrieve the DVD and your folder in the hall alcove and make sure all the necessary material is provided. Go to the lunchroom and fill a pitcher of water for your students. Extra cups are located in the cabinet beneath the microwave. Check your dry-erase markers to make sure that work. New markers are available in the metal mesh box in the hallway alcove. Start class <u>on time</u>.
Attendance	Be sure students write down the time they arrive and sign next to it on the attendance sheet as they arrive. • Students who arrive before the start time can enter the time class begins. • Students who leave at the time you dismiss the class can enter the dismissal time. • Students who arrive late or leave early need to write the actual time they arrive and/or leave.

GROWING PAINS

Two unexpected visitors surprise the employees at Crossroads Café. The first unexpected visitor is Margaret Reilly. She's an inspector with the Department of Health and Safety. She is looking for health and safety problems in the café.

The second unexpected visitor is Henry's uncle. He and his friend are at Crossroads Café for a take-out order. Henry doesn't want his uncle to see him because his parents don't know about his job.




