Determined Learner Achieves Dream

A long-time student and new business owner, Janeth Astudillo grew up in Ecuador. Forced to leave school at age 12 to work, she joined her husband in the United States in 2005. Their daughter soon joined them and the family grew. Janeth became frustrated because she was unable to communicate with her children's teachers before Vita was recommended to her. She enrolled in English as a Second Language classes. In time, Janeth's profieciency improved enough to pursue her GED, and she earned her high school equivalency in 2017, but that wasn't the end. She continued learning, expanding her skills in preparation for her new dream: owning and managing her own business.

In 2022, Janeth became the sole proprietor of a nail salon in Bucks County. When asked what advice she would give to other students, Janeth said, "It is OK to fail. As long as you are still learning, it is OK to fail. Everything is an experience and everything is connected and everything is to be appreciated."
